Hampton University Proton Therapy Institute's pediatric program has received another donation from the Chartway Promise Foundation

HAMPTON, Va. -- The Hampton University Proton Therapy Institute's (HUPTI) pediatric gift-giving program, HUPTI Smiles, has once again received a \$10,000 grant from the Chartway Promise Foundation (CPF) for use in the 2024 calendar year.

The donation will be used to buy gifts for the pediatric patients HUPTI treats in 2024 as the center continues to work on updates and renovations to its children's lounge to be more accessible and accommodating.

HUPTI Smiles, founded in 2021, is a specially designed, ongoing charitable program designed to address the emotional needs of pediatric cancer patients and their families. This initiative is a project where children and young adults being treated at HUPTI receive a new, wrapped toy or gift card during their treatments.

HUPTI has collaborated with leading medical centers such as the Children's Hospital of The King's Daughters (CHKD), Portsmouth Naval, Virginia Commonwealth University, The University of Virginia, etc., to ensure our young patients receive new gifts during their treatment, which can range up to 44 consecutive visits.

"We are so thankful to the Chartway Promise Foundation for their continued partnership and generosity for providing organizations like ours with opportunities to provide a smile for our little ones battling cancer," said Tiffany Rodgers, Director of Marketing at HUPTI and founder of HUPTI Smiles. "HUPTI Smiles is an important part of achieving our mission of easing human misery and saving lives because providing a positive outlet for children and their parents during an unbelievable time can give them just enough motivation to keep going. We understand how meaningful this project can be in helping the children and their families. I would like to thank the Chartway Promise Foundation."

Due to corporate and individual donations, as well as successful fundraising events, the Chartway Promise Foundation's board was able to approve \$1M in grants for use in 2024 to several non-profit charitable partners, including HUPTI Smiles, according to its website.

Proton therapy is universally accepted as a viable and effective method to treat many forms of cancer—one of the top killers in Virginia. It is a noninvasive option that precisely targets the tumor, sparing healthy tissue. At HUPTI, patients receive outpatient treatment in about 30 minutes, which means no hospital stays, allowing them to maintain their current lifestyle. The center treats several types of cancer, including breast, lung, prostate, head & neck, ocular, brain & spine, gastrointestinal and pediatric tumors.
